

Charity Recycling Bins

Hello, I run a family business in Newbury that recycles unwanted clothing. We provide clothing banks in and around Berkshire that fund local charities. We pay for all the clothes we collect and the money raised goes either to the council or to the charities direct. The charities we currently support are Newbury Cancer Care, Bracknell Mayor's Charity and Thames Hospice Care. We have over 50 clothing banks but need to acquire new sites regularly as there is a lot of competition from big business and bogus charities. If you think you may be able to provide any new sites then I would be happy to send you a proposal or arrange a meeting to discuss it.

The Clothing Warehouse in Newbury has been in business for over 20 years and has raised a huge sum of money which has helped local charities immensely as well as providing cheap clothing to local people. The more clothes we recycle the better and we are always looking for new sites. A good site is usually an area in or around a car park, it could be a recreation ground, community centre or school for example. The money raised can support one of the charities we are in partnership with or fund council projects like church roofs, playing fields or repairs to schools. We provide the clothing bank in any colour and clothes are collected on a regular basis by fully trained staff.
